

Regular Minutes
Liquor Board
May 15, 2017

The Dorchester County Board of License Commissioners met on May 15, 2017, in Room 110 of the Dorchester County Office Building with the following members present: Chairwoman Patti Tieder; Councilman Ricky Travers; Shirley Satterfield; Dwight Cromwell and Roger Short Liquor License Inspector. Councilman Tom Bradshaw and Patrick Thomas Attorney for the Board were not present.

The Board of License Commissioners convened in open session with Chairwoman Patti Tieder presiding.

The Board approved Regular minutes from the April 17, 2017 meeting.

An application and the documents for a transfer of a Class "B" Beer and Wine (on/off-sale) License were received and reviewed by the Board. The applicants, Jennifer Warrell and Cathy Phillips, T/A - The Warwick River Café 2.0, at 147 Main Street, Secretary, MD 21664 were present. All parties were sworn in by Inspector Roger Short. Chairwoman Patti Tieder discussed the responsibilities of a licensee with the applicants. Chairwomen Patti Tieder then asked Inspector Roger Short if they had a completed application. Inspector Roger Short stated that he was waiting for the Bulk Transfer Certificate and the letter from the State Comptroller's Office. With no further questions, a motion was made by Councilman Travers and seconded by Mr. Cromwell to approve the license contingent on receiving the Bulk Transfer Certificate and the State Comptrollers letter. A vote was called for and it was unanimous by all of the board members.

An application and the documents for a new Class "A" Beer and Wine (off-sale) License were received and reviewed by the Board. The applicant, Laura Wingfield, T/A Lewis General Store, at 1042 Hudson Rd, Cambridge, MD 21613 was present. Laura Wingfield was sworn in by Inspector Roger Short. Chairwoman Patti Tieder discussed the responsibilities of a licensee with the applicant. Chairwomen Patti Tieder then asked Inspector Roger Short if they had a completed application. Inspector Roger Short stated that he was waiting for the letter from the State Comptroller's Office. With no further questions, a motion was made by Councilman Travers and seconded by Ms. Satterfield to approve the license contingent on receiving the State Comptrollers letter. A vote was called for and it was unanimous by all of the board members.

An application for a Caterers License to be added to the Class "B" license of Slaughter Creek Marina, LLC T/A Palm Beach Willies. Robert Bromwell was present on behalf of Slaughter Creek Marina, LLC. Chairwoman Tieder asked Mr. Bromwell where the food catering will be coming from. Mr. Bromwell replied that the food will be coming from Palm Beach Willies location in Church Creek, MD and the alcohol from Palm Beach Willies in Taylors Island, MD. He also stated that the names will be the same on the food service and alcohol licenses that are all part of Slaughter Creek Marina LLC. The reason for the food coming from Church Creek is the kitchen space. Commissioner Travers advised Mr. Bromwell that there cannot be any alcohol at the Church Creek location. Chairwoman Tieder reiterated that the names must be exactly the same on the liquor license and the health department license. Chairwoman Tieder and Councilman Travers advised Mr. Bromwell again that even after catering an event they cannot unload any alcohol at the Church Creek location that it must go back to the Taylors Island location. If the Comptroller's office comes and inspects the Church Creek location that there could be fines for one bottle being at that location. Mr. Bromwell stated that he understood and is aware that the alcohol could not be at that location and that the names must match. A motion was made by Councilman Travers and seconded by Mr. Cromwell to approve the license. A vote was called for and it was unanimous by all of the board members.

An application and a letter of approval from the City of Cambridge for Public Consumption to be added to the license at Jimmie and Sooks were received and reviewed by the Board. Inspector Roger Short also had an application that was found in the file from 2011, which Amanda Bramble had submitted for public consumption. The board discussed that they believe that it could have been a mistake that was overlooked. Being that all documents were present for the application. A motion was made by Councilman Travers and seconded by Mr. Cromwell to approve the public consumption. A vote was called for and it was unanimous by all of the board members.


The next meeting is scheduled for June 19, 2017.


With no further business to discuss, the Board of License Commissioners was adjourned from Open Session.


